How do you track your hours and check deposits, fundraising amounts, letters etc.?

- 1. Click the link above and login using the email and password you used to apply.
- **2.** Once logged into your dashboard, you will see the following categories: payments total, service hours, work and earn hours, fundraising total, and letter campaign total.
- **3.** To track service hours, click the "View" button that is under the "Service Hours" section, then click "Add Service Hours". Enter all of the information requested and click "Create". Please be sure to update your service hours on the day you complete them.
- **4.** To track Work & Earn hours, click the "View" button that is under the "Work & Earn" section, then click "Create New". Enter all of the information requested and click "Create". Please be sure to update your Work & Earn hours on the day you complete them.

- 1. You will need your student's assistance (or their email and login information) during this process.
- **2.** Once you are logged in to your student's account, you will see a green bar at the very bottom of the screen that has a string of letters and numbers. Copy this "student key" before creating your account. You will need this "key" to link to your student's account.
- 3. Once you have copied the "student key", use the link above to create your own account.
- **4.** After you have created your account, you will see a button that reads "Add Student". Click this button, paste the "student key", then click the "link" button. Once linked, you will be able to view everything your student can see in their portal. This is also where you can track your payment progress.
- **5.** If you have several students in the program, you can link to multiple accounts using this process and their individual keys.



Student Mandatory Activities, Events and Meetings

Welcome to the Global Leaders family! We are looking forward to the amazing work that we will do together locally and internationally in the coming year. The events and meetings on these calendars are **MANDATORY** for all participants in GL. Please review them *closely* and don't hesitate to **ask questions**. You will be responsible for logging your service hours through our online student portal.

Student Events/Commitments:

WEEKLY:

Each GL student will work on a weekly service team project, which may include: tutoring/mentoring at Putnam or Lopez Elementary, Intercambio language exchange at PHS, Mobile Food Pantry and more TBD. Students must select at least <u>ONE</u> weekly service project. Some projects are twice per month for two hours rather than weekly for one hour.

MONTHLY:

LEADERSHIP AND SERVICE SEMINARS:

We have one mandatory seminar per month starting in October. These seminars are on Saturdays or Sundays from approximately 10am-4pm. (Some have different times- check the calendar!)

POUDRE FOOD PANTRY

Each student will be required to participate in **4 Food Pantry times throughout the year.** These are held bi-weekly each month at Poudre High School. The times are 4:30-6:30PM. You will get access to a Signup Genius at our first seminar. When you sign up you are LOCKED into those dates unless you have an emergency. Please consult your year-long calendar before signing up.

LUNCH MEETING:

Each school will have one mandatory lunch meeting per month at their school. The meeting will be on Thursdays the same week as the monthly seminar. The primary purpose of these will be team building and seminar prep. See GL calendar included in this packet for exact dates.

GL Fundraising Philosophy

Full-paying participants' fundraising expectations:

All full-paying participants are expected to participate in GL's three fundraising opportunities: letter writing campaign (23 letters), selling 10 bags of coffee, and selling minimum of 6 auction tickets. You and your donors will decide where your fundraised money will be distributed (local and international projects, Financial Assistance for students, or general operating costs).

Work & Earn participants fundraising expectations:

This is a need based award. If your family has extenuating circumstances that are not covered in the W&E Form, please communicate this with us. You must fill out the request form. In addition to the service learning opportunities, you will work an equivalent number of "Work & Earn" hours (at \$20 in GL "dollars" per hour) to honor your award.

Students seeking Financial Assistance must understand and have completed the following steps:

- 1. Fill out the **GL Work & Earn Request** and email to <u>info@globalleadersinc.org</u> ideally by 10/04/2024 with your \$100 deposit.
- 2. **IF NEEDED:** schedule a meeting with one of our staff members, to create a payment plan that works for your family. **This meeting can be accomplished via email, phone call, or in person.**
 - This plan will be a combination of what you can afford to pay, the award you request, and how much you think you can fundraise.
 - If you raise more money than your goal, you will be supporting other Financial Assistance students, or the Project Fund. Additional fundraising does NOT decrease the amount your family has agreed to pay.
- 3. You will be given Financial Assistance for the remainder of the program cost after your payment goal and fundraising goal; the maximum Financial Assistance for the Guatemala Program is 50% of the Program Fee plus airfare (approx. \$850).
- 4. With Work & Earn program, you'll be responsible for honoring your award by completing Work & Earn hours.
 - You will create a plan to complete your Work & Earn hours at the beginning of the year, so that you're prepared to meet the additional responsibility there is a worksheet in your GL folder to help!
 - You're responsible for logging your Work & Earn hours through our online portal.

ALL STUDENTS PLEASE NOTE: the amount your family agrees to pay at the beginning of the year is what your family pays, regardless of whether you fundraise an amount greater than your goal. If you fundraise an amount greater than your goal, that money goes toward projects and scholarship, not toward your own program costs. ADDITIONALLY, if you do NOT meet your fundraising and Work & Earn goals, your family is responsible for the additional payment(s).

Annual Fundraisers:

GL offers four (4) fundraising opportunities that all students have access to in order to reach their fundraising goals. Some of these fundraisers are required! Last year, journey students averaged \$750 each in fundraising.

Strategy Matters! Consider the following:

- You will be taking part in three (3) fundraisers not every person in your network is going to be interested in supporting all three (or any!) Take time to plan who would be the best fit for each fundraiser.
 - **LETTERS**: Out of town family and friends are the best candidates
 - o **AUCTION ATTENDANCE:** Family, neighbors, teachers, youth group leaders
 - o **COFFEE**: door to door, at parents' work places, at church or community center
 - o KING SOOPERS Membership: assigning GL as your preferred non profit

Letter writing campaign: (2023-2024 NET TOTALS: \$41,115 – 78 students, avg: \$527/student)

All Participants are expected to write 23 fundraising letters to family, friends and businesses. GL staff will provide the letter templates, envelopes and guidance.

WHEN: Letters will be completed and delivered to GL Staff by October 18th.

OTHER INFO: Completed letters means: MINIMUM number of 23 letters written, printed, personal message on each letter, envelopes addressed and signed by students. DO NOT SEAL ENVELOPES! GL WILL COLLECT & MAIL THESE BY OCTOBER 18TH.

For Work & Earn students every dollar received from letters goes towards the student's scholarship or fundraising goal. For Full pay students the money raised will go towards either other students' scholarships or

to project costs.*Each donor will receive a tax deductible/thank you letter within 48 hours of GL receiving the donation. Each participant and parent will have access to all of his or her fundraising info through the student portal.

Fiesta de Global Leaders Benefit Auction: (2024 TICKET SALES TOTAL: \$9,127) (\$54,791 net profit)

This is our most profitable event and requires commitment and hard work from all students and parents. For Work and Earn students, every dollar from ticket sales by students and parents goes towards the student's scholarship or fundraising goal. (Tickets will be \$50). ALL students will be expected to sell 6 auction tickets. GL will provide a list of past attendees to assist with reaching the ticket sales goal. *Please note that it costs GL about \$25 per head to pull off this event* **POTENTIALLY 2 AUCTIONS THIS YEAR ON BACK-TO-BACK NIGHTS (TBD)**

WHEN: Saturday, April 19th, 2024, 6-9pm [set up for students all day Saturday, possibly Friday night]

OTHER INFO: Parents assist in all aspects of the Auction and will be organized into committees at the November meeting.

Coffee Sales: (2024 GROSS TOTAL: \$8,553)

The GL team from 2024 purchased 300 bags of coffee through fundraising efforts to support this year's team.

WHEN: NOW!

OTHER INFO: LOCAL STUDENTS NOT REQUIRED (but encouraged) TO SELL COFFEE. The GL cost for each bag is \$8.

You will sell each of your 10 bags for \$15 (a piece). ALL WORK AND EARN AND TRAVELING STUDENTS will receive \$15 credit for all bags sold.

King Soopers Rewards:

HOW IT WORKS: King Soopers donates 2.5% of each grocery purchase to community causes when you use your King Soopers account for purchases. This is NO COST to you, and you can select Global Leaders as the recipient of your 3%. The sign up process takes about 2 minutes!

Global Leaders Work & Earn Program

One of Global Leaders' (GL) main goals is to ensure that our program is available to all who are interested, regardless of financial resources.

WORK AND EARN (W&E) DEFINED:

Our W&E Program is a way for students whose families cannot afford to completely pay the program fee to work off a portion of their fee. The program is similar to Work Study in college. Students are paid \$20/ hour in "GL Dollars". Each hour a student works at the GL Office reduces their program fee by \$20. Our W&E students are critical to the success of GL; they provide great value to our organization. They are working/learning skills such as grant writing, seminar planning, logistical organization and much more. The Work and Earn amount a student receives will vary according to a family's financial situation. The assistance you receive is based on family income, number of dependents, and fundraising capacity.

- 1. **GL has allocated \$20,000** for W&E to assist with program fees for families this year. Once we have received all W&E applications, we then divide the allocated funds to students based on need.
- 2. **W&E awards are based on a sliding scale** The maximum award is 50% of the program fees plus airfare. Regardless of the W&E award you receive, all students are expected to participate in the 3-4 GL Fundraisers.
- 3. GL staff, students, the Board of Directors, and parent volunteers work tirelessly to fundraise to support the Work and Earn needs. We have received generous support from a number of Foundations and OtterCares has been the most generous through the years.
- 4. **Project Fund: Unlike many organizations; GL fundraises and pays for all the projects we complete locally and internationally.** Our international project fund pays for building schools, installing cookstoves, reforestation, and supporting Hermano Pedro Hospital in Guatemala
- 5. **Each student, regardless of whether they receive a W&E award, are expected to participate in our 3-4 fundraising efforts.** These fundraisers include a letter writing campaign, selling 10 bags of coffee and selling 3-4 benefit auction tickets. Typically we add one additional new fundraiser.
- 6. **Program Fee:** The program fee is set based on the cost of our operations locally and abroad. It pays for meeting space, curriculum development, programming, event planning, office space, supplies, insurance, and personnel. For those that travel, the program fee pays for lodging, meals, programming, cultural exchanges and excursions, transportation, host families costs, language class and personnel in Guatemala. Only a portion of the program fee goes to projects, which is why fundraising is so essential to the GL experience.
